



Amongst the challenges we have been tackling in Year 4, we have been measuring in different units. Here we are measuring different areas of the playground to then find the perimeters. Afterwards we used our skills with place value to write m and cm measurements in just metres or just centimetres.



Year 5 have had a great term in maths. We started off with a super-interesting investigation on mathematical patterns. As the term progressed we had great fun examining 2d and 3d shapes and then followed this with an investigation of distance, working out how far places are from each other in both miles and kms.



In Year one this term we have covered a variety of topics in order to assess our current knowledge. This has included a lot activities for counting in 1s, 2s and 10s, telling the time to the whole and half past the hour, identifying shapes resulting in the production of a shape monster and recognising and using money. This tied in well with our Toy topic as we used our money knowledge to buy and sell things in our role play toy shop. We also spent time cracking the code for treasure by demonstrating different ways to make money amounts.



In Nursery the Maths this term has been very practical. Every morning we include a maths activity or game in our learning, although a valuable amount of learning comes through child initiated activities. Here you can see the children are comparing heights and lengths when using construction equipment.
