Bus Passes

Important note for students who have current bus passes issued

September 2016;

Students currently travelling to school



by bus (vehicles larger than 16 seats), will **not** receive a new pass during the Summer Holidays. Your current pass will be valid until the end of your schooling (for pupils aged 5-16) at your current school. However, in some circumstances, where a school's transport has been reviewed, students may be transferred onto a different route with a new bus number. Any students that this affects, **will** receive a new bus pass during the Summer holidays for their new route, please keep hold of your current pass until you receive your new one.

You must keep your pass, please do not destroy or lose the pass, as you will be required to pay £10 charge for a replacement if you do so. Post 16 (College and 6th form) need to apply for bus passes each year, please visit our website www.norfolk.gov.uk
