We have been really impressed with how well the children have settled back into school after half term. It sounds like you all had a great break. We have loved seeing the children's homework and half term adventures on tapestry, thank you.

Our new topic is 'Cinderella', the children have started learning the story, acting it out and putting music to the story. We have many exciting activities planned for this half term.

This week our phonics has continued with learning the last few sounds of Set 1. The children are trying hard and succeeding with reading simple 3 letter words and their writing is coming on well.

In our number work we have been counting with 1:1 correspondence and counting bigger numbers. We have also been writing numerals 0-9, the children need lots of practise with this.

Also this week we have had PE in the hall, the children all need to have plimsolls in school for this. Remember too that wellington boots are needed for our outdoor and woodland learning.

Congestion in the classroom has been an issue, especially in the mornings. Therefore could we please ask you to leave your pushchairs outside. Of course younger siblings are most welcome in the class. If one of your younger children is asleep during drop off or pick up we can arrange for a member of staff to meet you and bring your child to you.
