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Uniform

At Wells Primary and Nursery School we take pride in our appearance and our lovely uniform, thank you to all of those parents who consistently ensure that their child has the right uniform to wear each day. All the children need black school shoes **NOT TRAINERS**. If your child has grown out of certain items at this point in the year, second hand school uniform can be purchased from the canteen for £1 per item. Thank you for your co-operation with this matter.

Foodbank

The summer holidays can be tough for families that normally rely on meals provided by schools, and we wanted to let you know how to access the Foodbank's services. There are two steps:

- The first is to obtain a voucher. There are nearly 90 organisations in our network that can issue vouchers, such as Citizen's Advice Bureau, Social Services, housing associations, children's services, health services and job centres.
- The second is to present the voucher at one of our distribution centres in exchange for food (non-food items such as toiletries and nappies are generally available, too). Full details of locations and opening times of the centres are here: <https://midnorfolk.foodbank.org.uk/locations/>.

At Mid-Norfolk Foodbank, visitors are treated with the utmost discretion and in strictest confidence. They understand that nobody visits through choice, so they seek to make the process as painless as possible.
