**Reminder:** Our class assembly will be on Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> June at 9:10am, we look forward to seeing you.

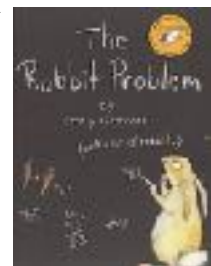


#### Year 2
