







Wells Primary and Nursery School Reception Class Newsletter 10<sup>th</sup> June





Dear Parents/ Carers,




This term we are learning about minibeasts, this week we have started with worms! We have read the story 'Superworm', the children have enjoyed digging for worms and observing them, we then made some wormeries to put them in. We are going to watch what happens over the next few weeks to see how they tunnel and move through the soil.




The children have started to write a worm fact file, after finding out lots of information about worms. We have developed our fine motor skills by using tweezers to collect pipe cleaner worms from the shredded paper. Picking up spaghetti worms with our fingers and measuring them. We talked about the Superworm story and how Superworm was feeling, what he was thinking and saying when he got taken by the crow. Then the children wrote about it, we have displayed these on the writing wall.



In maths we have been comparing different length string worms, putting them in size order and measuring them using cubes. We have rolled out playdough worms and measured them using rulers. The children enjoyed laying down on the floor next to the metre rule to find out who was longer, shorter or the same length.



Please can you ensure that your child has their PE kit in school with trainers for doing PE outside. They also need to have a hat for when the weather is sunny, as we have no shade outside if they do not have a hat then we will not be able to let them go outside.



On Monday 4<sup>th</sup> July we will be going to Holkham for the day, if you are able to come long and help please can you let us know. You would need to make your own way there and back.
