

Hello Everyone,

The children have settled in beautifully this week, we are really proud of them! There has been a lot for them to take in and get used to, they are very tired!

Over the next couple of weeks your children are going to get increasingly tired as they get used to full time school. Please make sure that they have lots of sleep and an early bedtime, so they come into school refreshed and ready to learn.

We are going to start teaching phonics on Monday. Each day that we learn a new sound your child will bring home a sheet to recap and review the sound they have learnt that day. Please support your child to complete this and talk to them about the phoneme they have learnt. You do not need to return the sheet to school. We will be running a phonics session for parents soon, where you can learn how best to support your child with their phonics, writing and reading.

Please check the notice board in the cloakroom everyday, as we will write important notices and messages here each day. If your child is going to be collected by someone different please write this on the message board on the door as you enter the classroom.

Don't forget your child needs to have a pair of wellie boots that can stay at school everyday. They also need to have a bag of spare clothes on their peg.

Today your child has been given their learning log. Please support your child to complete the homework activities inside and return their learning log to the box in the cloakroom by Thursday of the following week. They have also been given a red home school link book. We will write in these on a Friday telling you about how your child has been at school that week. Please feel free to write in these if there is something that you need to ask/ tell us and you are unable to speak to us in person. We will check the bus children's books regularly but will not check every child's book everyday.

One Monday 19th September it is meet the teacher afternoon. The school is open from 3.30pm - 4.30pm for you to come into the classroom, talk to us and look at what your child has been doing so far, we look forward to seeing you.
