We had a fantastic start to the week with a visit from the mini monsters. The children really enjoyed meeting all the different creatures and finding out all about them. We read the story of The Very Busy Spider to the children, the children then chose a character from the story and wrote what they said in the story. They have made webs on paper plates, looked at the maths in a spiders web and recreated their own webs, drawn spiderweb pictures and took on the web challenge in the outdoor area! Where they had to get through the giant spiders web without disturbing the spider.

Next week we are going to begin learning about butterflies and caterpillars and we will be reading the story of The Very Hungry Caterpillar. If your child has any caterpillar or butterfly stories that they would like to bring in, we would love to read them.

On Thursday 30th at 9.10am we have our class assembly. Please come and watch, as the children are very keen to show you what they have been learning this term.
