

Medium Term Plan      Wells Nursery School      Spring Term 1, 2018  
Topic - The stars, the moon and aliens.

This is a good challenge to get children into the habit of hearing lots of questions. They need to be exposed to 'I wonder' and 'What would happen if' questions and to be encouraged to ask their own questions and make their own links. It is also a good challenge to initiate deeper discussion at home and to start to listen to each other's ideas and opinions.

All areas of the curriculum will be covered each week through continuous provision. Further in depth weekly plans show child led activities with highlighted areas being adult led initially.

Letter and sound work is covered daily, as is number work.

<p><b>Week 1</b></p> <p>4.1.2018</p>	<p>As in Autumn Term 1 the main focus for these two days is to settle in our new children- separating from main carer with support where needed Encourage the older children to work with our new children, whether they are working with each other or alongside. Introduce carpet time though simple action songs and rhymes. Set basic class rules- eg explain our rolling snack system</p>
<p><b>Week 2</b></p> <p>8.1.2017</p>	<p>What happens when I am asleep? Read "Peace at Last!" Why do I go to sleep? Text "Can't you sleep Little Bear?" RE- 36-48 months- acts out experiences in their play, using objects to represents different things. R- 37-42 months- use their own props to retell a story. R- 43-48 months- Knows that print carries meaning and how to handle books.</p>
<p><b>Week 3</b></p> <p>15.1.2017</p>	<p>Read 'Owl Babies'. Why does the Owl mummy fly away? Discuss "nocturnal". What do you think she was doing when she left her babies on their own? UW- 37- 42 months- Talks about events in their personal history and present lives. UW- 43- 48 months- Understands that different people perform different roles. M- 37-42 months- Makes comparisons between different quantities.</p>
<p><b>Week 4</b></p> <p>22.1.2017</p>	<p>Continue with the text "Owl Babies". What noises can you hear at night? Listen to a selection of noises made by night time creatures, can you identify them? UW- 37-42 months- Shows care and concern for living things and the environment. UW- 43-48 months- Responds to experiences and explorations of why things happen and how things work in the natural and man-made world.</p>
<p><b>Week 5</b></p> <p>29.1.2017</p>	<p>What can you see in the sky at night? Read "Whatever Next!" Make our own Nursery School rocket. EAD- 37-42 months- Creates or builds new "worlds", stories or scenarios. EAD- 43-48 months- Uses a resource or material in a different or unusual way, showing intent as they do so.</p>
<p><b>Week 6</b></p> <p>5.2.2018</p>	<p>Who do you think lives on the moon? Read the text "Aliens love Underpants!" R- 37-42 months- Engages in story talk when in role play or in small world. R- 43-48 months- Knows that print carries meaning and how to handle books. EAD- 37-42 months- Creates or builds new "worlds", stories or scenarios. EAD- 43-48 months- Uses a resource or material in a different or unusual way, showing intent as they do so.</p>
