

We have enjoyed our Science Week, learning about change.

We started with a story about "Elmer the Elephant". He is a rainbow coloured, patchwork elephant, who tricks his friends by changing colour.

We mixed old fashioned soap flakes with water to make a bubbly mix. The children then added different colour powder paints and watched as new colours were created as they mixed.



The soapy mix then became part of the children's role play activities.



We also mixed dyed rice to create a new colour and looked through coloured cellophane. The cellophane made everything look different!



Finally, we took a look in the school pond and found some frogspawn. We carefully collected a little lump of the jellylike eggs and created a habitat for it in the Nursery. We hope the frogspawn will change into tadpoles if we look after it properly.
