We have recently combed the woods looking for anything that Stone Age people could have used for food. Then we had another look to see if there were any materials that they might have used for cave paintings.

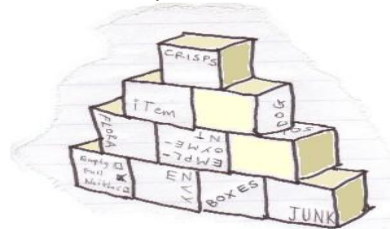


And more news -Year 2
